Conjugation: FITC

Purification: This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography, followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities.

Conjugation Note: 3.2 moles FITC per mole of rabbit IgG

Recommend Usage: The optimal working dilution should be determined by the end user.

Storage Buffer: Lyophilized from 10 mM KH₂PO₄, 150 mM NaCl, pH 7.2 (0.01% sodium azide)

Storage Instruction: Store at 4°C on dry atmosphere. After reconstitution with 1 mL of deionized water, store at -20°C or lower.

Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
