Storage Buffer: Lyophilized from 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M NaCl, pH 7.2 (0.01% sodium azide, 10 mg/mL BSA (Immunoglobulin and Protease free))

Storage Instruction: Store at 4°C on dry atmosphere. After reconstitution with 1 mL of deionized water, store at -20°C or lower.

Aliquot to avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
