Format:	State: Lyophilized purified Ig fraction. Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography. Buffer System: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2 with 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum Albumin (BSA, IgG and Protease free) as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Sodium azide as preservative. Label: Texas Red – (TM) Sulfonyl Chloride (Molecular Weight 625 daltons) <i>Absorption / Emission:</i> 596 nm / 620 nm <i>Molar Ratio:</i> 2.8 moles Texas Red(TM) per mole of Rabbit IgG. Reconstitution: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).
Applications:	Suitable for Immunomicroscopy and Flow cytometry or FACS analysis as well as other antibody based fluorescent assays requiring lot-to-lot consistency. Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should be determined by the user.
Specificity:	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Donkey IgG coupled to agarose beads. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit Serum, Donkey IgG and Donkey Serum.
Storage:	Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: One year from despatch.
