

Polyclonal Antibody to Rabbit IgG F(ab')₂ -FITC-

Format:	State: Lyophilized purified IgG fraction. Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography. Buffer System: 0.01 M Sodium Phosphate, 0.14 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.4, containing 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum Albumin (BSA) IgG and Protease free, and 0.01% (w/v) Thimerisol Label: FITC – Diaminotriazinylaminofluorescein (DTAF) (Molecular Weight 530 daltons) <i>Absorption / Emission:</i> 495 nm / 528 nm <i>Molar Ratio:</i> 3.7 moles DTAF per mole of Goat IgG. Reconstitution: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water or equivalent.
Applications:	Suitable for Immunomicroscopy and Flow cytometry or FACS analysis as well as other antibody based fluorescent assays requiring lot-to-lot consistency. Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should be determined by the user.
Specificity:	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Rabbit IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Fluorescein, anti-Goat Serum, Rabbit IgG, Rabbit IgG F(ab) ₂ and Rabbit Serum. No reaction was observed against Rabbit IgG F(c).
Storage:	Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: One year from despatch.
