Applications: This product is designed for Immunofluorescence Microscopy, fluorescence based plate

assays (FLISA) and fluorescent western blotting. This product is also suitable for multiplex

analysis, including multicolor imaging, utilizing various commercial platforms.

Recommended Dilutions: FLISA: 1/10,000-1/50,000

Immunofluorescence: 1/1,000-1/5,000 Flow Cytometry: 1/500-1/2,500

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should

be determined by the user.

Specificity: This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by Immunoaffinity

Chromatography using Mouse IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities, pepsin digestion and chromatographic

separation.

Assay by Immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Goat

Serum, Mouse IgG, Mouse IgG F(c) and Mouse Serum.

No reaction was observed against anti-Pepsin, anti-Goat IgG F(c), Mouse IgG F(ab')2 or

Bovine, Horse and Human Serum Proteins.



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Storage:

Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent). For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: One year from despatch.
