

Polyclonal Antibody to Sheep IgG [H&L] - TRITC-

Host: Rabbit

Immunogen: Sheep IgG whole molecule.

Format: State: Lyophilized purified Ig fraction.

Absorption / Emission: 550 nm / 570 nm

Molar Ratio: 3.2 moles TRITC per mole of Rabbit IgG

Reconstitution: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Applications: Suitable for Immunomicroscopy and Flow Cytometry or FACS analysis as well as other

antibody based fluorescent assays requiring extremely low background levels, absence of

F(c) mediated binding, lot-to-lot consistency, high titer and specificity.

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should

be determined by the user.

Specificity: This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by Immunoaffinity

chromatography using Sheep IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase

adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities.

Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Rabbit

Serum, Sheep IgG and Sheep Serum.

Storage: Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration.

For extended storage mix with Glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room

temperature.

This product is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: one year from despatch.
