

## Monoclonal Antibody to CD45 / LCA (CD45RA) - FITC

Alternate names: L-CA, Leukocyte common antigen, PTPRC, Receptor-type tyrosine-protein phosphatase C,

Background: CD45RA is a high molecular weight isoform of a receptor-type protein tyrosine

phosphatase, CD45 glycoprotein. CD45 is crucial in lymphocyte development and antigen signaling, serving as an important regulator of Src-family kinases, promotes cell survival by modulating integrin-mediated signal transduction pathway and is also involved in DNA fragmentation during apoptosis. CD45 isoforms differ in their extracellular domains, whereas they share identical transmembrane and cytoplasmic domains. These isoforms differ in their ability to translocate into the glycosphingolipid-enriched membrane domains and their expression depends on cell type and physiological state of the cell. CD45RA is

expressed e.g. on nave T cells and normal plasma cells.

reagent is free of unconjugated and adjusted for direct use

Applications: Flow Cytometry analysis of human blood cells using 20 μl

reagent / 100 µl of whole blood or 10e6 cells in a suspension.

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should

be determined by the user.

**Specificity:** The antibody MEM-56 reacts with CD45RA, a 205-220 kDa single chain type I glycoprotein,

variant of CD45 (CD45RA isoform). CD45RA is expressed on most of B lymphocytes, resting

and native T lymphocytes, medullar thymocytes and monocytes.

Species: Human.

be protected from light.

Shelf life: one year from despatch.
