

Monoclonal Antibody to CD18 / ITGB2 - PE

Alternate names: 95 subunit beta, Cell surface adhesion glycoproteins LFA-1/CR3/p150, Complement

Background: CD18 is an integrin. Integrins are integral cell surface proteins composed of an alpha chain

and a beta chain. A given chain may combine with multiple partners resulting in different integrins. For example, beta 2 combines with the alpha L chain to form the integrin LFA1, and combines with the alpha M chain to form the integrin Mac1. Integrins are known to participate in cell adhesion as well as cell surface mediated signalling. CD18 is expressed by most leucocytes. Defects in the CD18 gene result in leukocyte adhesion deficiency.

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should

be determined by the user.

Specificity: This antibody recognises CD18 (LFA-1), a 95-100kD cell surface glycoprotein expressed as a

heterodimer with CD11a, b or c. Functionally it inhibits homotypic aggregation of PHA

blasts. It also blocks binding of rat lymphocytes to purified rat ICAM-1.

Species: Rat.

Other species not tested.

Storage: Prior to and following reconstitution store the antibody at 2-8°C.
