

Mouse monoclonal antibody to AP-2 complex subunit alpha-adaptin [Ada-1]: IgG

Description: Assembly Polypeptides (AP), also known as adaptors, co-assemble with clathrin during the

formation of clathrin coated membranes. AP2 adaptors are associated with the endocytic clathrin coated vesicles at the plasma membrane. The AP2 adaptor is composed of four subunits which includes alpha- and beta-adaptin. This antibody reacts specifically with the

alpha-adaptin subunit of the AP2 adaptor.

Applications: Western Blotting (WB). A concentration of 2.0-4.0 µg/ml is recommended for WB. Human alpha

adaptin (isoform #1) has a predicted length of 977 residues and MW of 108 kDa. Biosensis

recommends optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Specificity: The specificity of this antibody has been confirmed by WB against the antigen.

Cross-reactivity: Human; rat;

Form: Lyophilized from 1.2% sodium acetate, 2mg BSA, 0.01mg NaN3

Reconstitute in 1 ml of PBS (pH 7.4) to achieve an antibody concentration of 100 µg/ml.

Centrifuge to remove any insoluble material.

Storage: At least 12 months after purchase at 2 - 4°C (lyophilized formulations). After reconstitution,

aliquot and store at -20°C for a higher stability. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.
