temperature to dissolve. Centrifuge to remove any particulates. Prepare fresh

working dilution daily.

Storage: Store freeze-dried powder at 2-8 °C.

Shelf Life: Product is stable for up to 4 weeks at 2-8°C after rehydration. For extended

storage after rehydration, add an equal volume of glycerol and store at -20°C.

Specificity: Based on IEP, this antibody reacts with:

kappa (κ) light chains on all human immunoglobulins

Cross Reactivity: Based on IEP, no reactivity is observed to:

• non-immunoglobulin human serum immunoglobulins

• heavy chains on all human immunoglobulins

• lambda (λ) light chains on all human immunoglobulins

a registered veterinarian.
