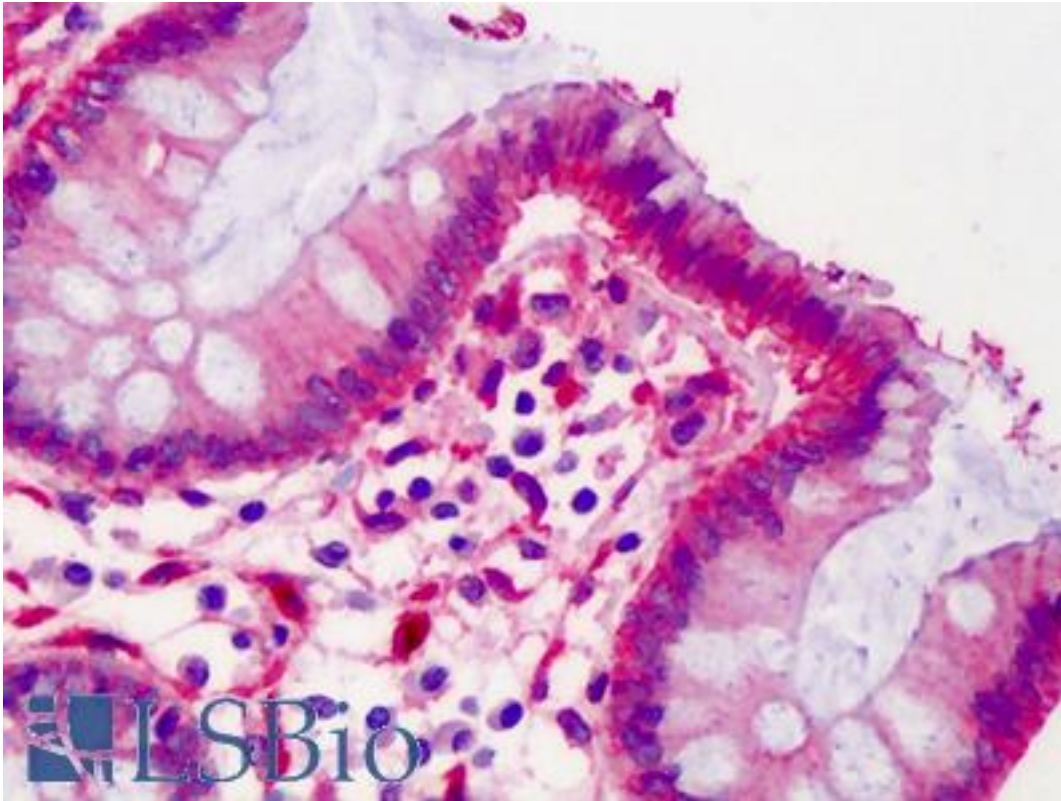

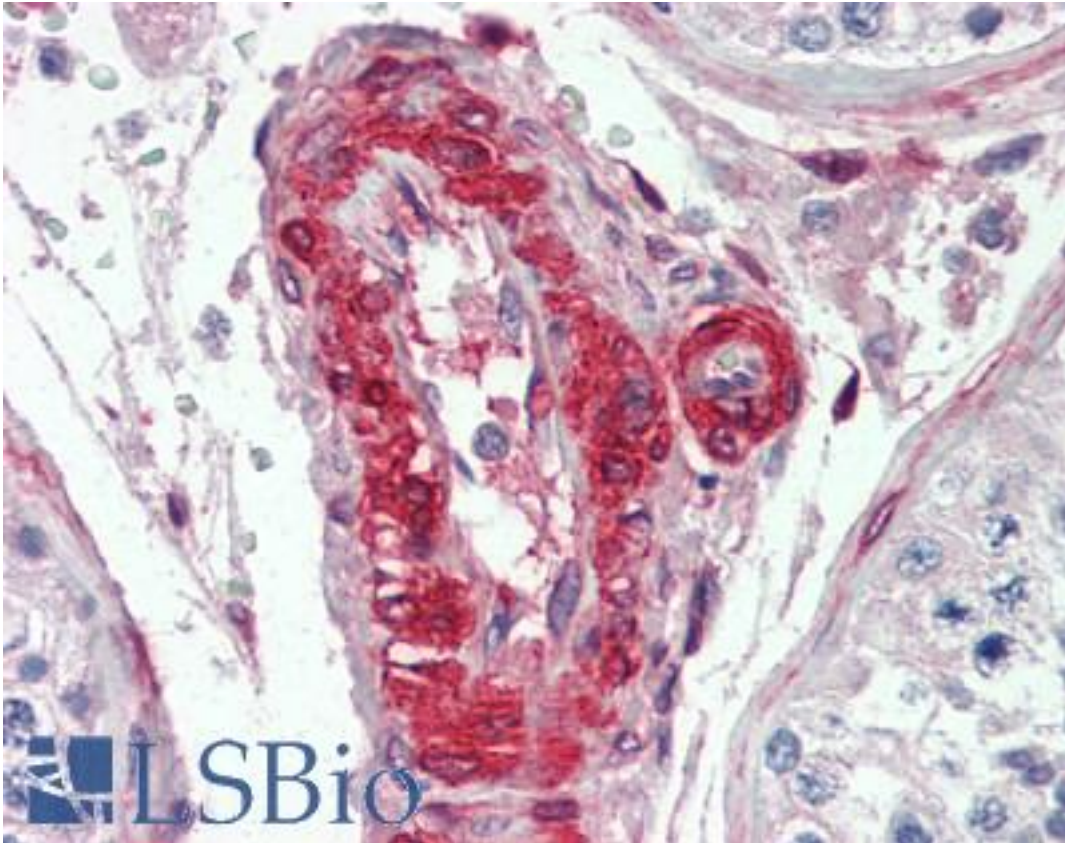

Usage Summary:	Immunohistochemistry: LS-B3472 was validated for use in immunohistochemistry on a panel of 21 formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded (FFPE) human tissues after heat induced antigen retrieval in pH 6.0 citrate buffer. After incubation with the primary antibody, slides were incubated with biotinylated secondary antibody, followed by alkaline phosphatase-streptavidin and chromogen. The stained slides were evaluated by a pathologist to confirm staining specificity. The optimal working concentration for LS-B3472 was determined to be 1:200.
Uses:	IHC - Paraffin (1:200), Immunofluorescence (1:200 - 1:1000), Western blot (1:500 - 1:2000), ELISA (1:10000) (Optimal dilution to be determined by the researcher)
