




Recommended Storage:	Store Lyophilized at room temperature up to 1 month; Reconstituted for up to two weeks at 2-8°C. Aliquot and freeze at -20°C for long term storage. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
Usage Summary:	Immunohistochemistry: LS-B7397 in an IHC-plus antibody, validated by our pathologists for use in IHC against formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded human tissues (IHC validation procedure). A concentration of 5 ug/ml is recommended. Neutralization: To yield one-half maximal inhibition [ND] of the biological activity of hIL-17A (50 ng/ml), a concentration of 0.9-1.3 ug/ml of this antibody is required. ELISA: To detect hIL-17A by sandwich ELISA (using 100 ul/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5-2 ug/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with Biotinylated Anti-Human IL-17A (LS-C104417) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2-0.4 ng/well of recombinant hIL-17A. Western Blot: To detect hIL-17A by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1-0.2 ug/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hIL-17A is 1.5-3 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.
Uses:	IHC - Paraffin (5 μg/ml), Western blot (0.1 - 0.2 μg/ml), ELISA (0.5 - 2 μg/ml), Neutralization (0.9 - 1.3 μg/ml) (Optimal dilution to be determined by the researcher)




Western Blot (reducing) of IL-17 antibody LS-B7397
