Usage Summary:	This 1D3 (1D3) antibody has been tested by flow cytometric analysis of mouse splenocyte suspensions. This can be used at less than or equal to 0.5 ug per test. A test is defined as the amount (ug) of antibody that will stain a cell sample in a final volume of 100 ul. Cell number should be determined empirically but can range from 10^5 to 10^8 cells/test. It is recommended that the antibody be carefully titrated for optimal performance in the assay of interest.
Uses:	IHC - Frozen, Immunoprecipitation, Flow Cytometry (Optimal dilution to be determined by the researcher)
Size:	50 µg or 100 µg or 500 µg
