Presentation:	0.02 M potassium phosphate, 0.15 M sodium chloride, pH 7.2, 10 mg/ml BSA (IgG, protease free), 0.01% sodium azide.
Recommended Storage:	Store at 4°C. Do not freeze.
Usage Summary:	Suitable for immunomicroscopy and flow cytometry or FACS analysis as well as other antibody based fluorescent assays requiring extremely low background levels, absence of F(c) mediated binding, lot-to-lot consistency, high titer and specificity. The maximum amount of reagent required to stain 1 x 106 cells in flow cytometry is approximately 1.0 ug of antibody conjugate. Lesser amounts of reagent may be sufficient for staining. As a general guideline dilutions of 1:50 to 1:200 should be suitable for most applications.
