

Mouse splenocytes were stained with Rat Anti-Mouse CD4 APC-conjugated Monoclonal Antibody (Catalog # FAB54A) and either (A) Rat Anti-Mouse CXCR3 Alexa Fluor® 488-conjugated Monoclonal Antibody (Catalog # FAB1685G) or (B) Rat IgG_{2A} Alexa Fluor 488 Isotype Control (Catalog # IC006G). BACKGROUND

CXCR3 is a G protein coupled chemokine receptor that binds the α chemokines MIG (CXCL9), IP-10 (CXCL10) and I-TAC (CXCL11). CXCR3 is expressed on activated T cells, B cells and NK cells.
