BACKGROUND

Integrin β 7 associates with the integrin α 4 or α E subunits to form heterodimers to interact with fibronectin, VCAM, MAdCAM or E-Cadherin. It is highly expressed in leukocytes and is involved in localization of leukocytes at mucosal sites.

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
