

Background Information:

Geodin, which is a metabolic product containing two chlorine, was isolated from *Aspergillus terreus*¹⁾. Geodin is a seco-anthraquinone derivated from an octaketide anthraquinone. Geodin acts as an inhibitor of plasminogen activator inhibitor (PAI-1)²⁾

Handling and Storage:

Store at -20°C.
