

Background Information:

Ambuic acid was isolated from Pestalotiopsis sp. and Monochaetia sp., and showed antimicrobial activity against the Gram-positive bacterium. It inhibited the biosynthesis of the cyclic peptide quormones of Staphylococcus aureus and Listeria innocua.

Handling and Storage:

Store at -20°C.
